Peter Pan will come to life in one of the most spectacular settings in England, with views across Morecambe Bay towards the peaks of the Lake District. As the leafy dells, woodlands and grassy knolls become Neverland, the stage is set for a very special summer evening's entertainment.

The Dukes is a pioneer of promenade theatre and this year will be celebrating 24 years of producing the event.
